HOW HTF WORKS

The HTF journey

One path in seven steps, from a public summit that reaches thousands, into a focused cohort, and onward into real opportunities. Each step leads into the next.

01

Discover

SUMMIT · 1,000+

A one-day public summit on AI, digital skills, technology careers and opportunities. The entry point, where young people are invited to apply.

02

Submit Application

Interested young people apply to join Cohort 1 after the summit.

03

Select

30-50 FELLOWS

30 fellows are selected to start, expandable to 50 as support allows.

04

Learn

4-WEEK INTENSIVE

Hands-on training across AI, digital skills and technology paths. Learning by doing, not lecture-heavy theory.

05

Build

Every fellow builds a real project they can show and keep developing.

06

Showcase

DEMO DAY

Fellows present their work at Demo Day and graduate from the fellowship.

07

Advance

Fellows are connected onward to real opportunities, and join a growing alumni community that keeps building together.
